The trust in the name of Education Board Mulund Colony was formed in the year 1950 to cater to the education needs of immigrants who migrated from sind Pakistan in the year 1948 & 1949, who were rehabilitated in Military Barracks made available by Central Government located in extreme end of Mulund town. The Trust is registered as public charitable trust with Charity Commissioner Mumbai region under No. F-556. The aims and objects of the trust are to provide education facilities to all the residents of Mulund irrespective of Caste, Creed or Community. Trust initially started with secondary school in the name of Jai Bharat High School with Sindhi as medium of instruction in the year 1950 taking into account the needs of the residents at that time. Trust has emerged out as one of primer education provider running schools and colleges providing education right from pre-primarily level to graduation level in Mulund.

## **Examination - Guidelines**

### **PASSING STANDARD:**

The learners to pass a course shall have to obtain a minimum of 40% marks in aggregate for each course where the course of Internal Assessment & Semester End Examination. The learners shall obtain minimum of 40% (i.e. 10 out of 25) in the Internal Assessment and 40% marks in Semester End Examination (i.e. 30 out of 75) separately, to pass the course and minimum of Grade E in each project, wherever applicable, to pass a particular semester. A learner will be said to have passed the course if the learner passes the Internal Assessment & Semester End Examination together.

### **Eligibility for Admission to Second and Third year of UG Degree Programmes under Credit Based Semester and Grading System:**

#### **Eligibility criteria for a learner, to be admitted in Second Year**

Shall have passed Semester I and II in full

**OR**

Fails in not more than Two Courses in each Semester I and II of First Year.

#### **Eligibility Criteria for a learner, to be admitted in Third Year:**

- 1) Shall have passed Semester I, II, III and IV in full

**OR**

- 2) Shall have secured I and II in full and secured A.T.K.T in the Second Year by failing in not more than Two Courses in each of Semester III and Semester IV

**OR**

- 3) Shall have secured A.T.K.T in First Year by failing in not more than two Courses in each of Semester I and Semester II and have passed Semester III and Semester IV in full.

A learner shall be allowed to keep terms for Semester VI irrespective of grades obtained in each course of Semester V. There result of Semester VI shall be kept in abeyance once until the learner passes each of Semester I, Semester II, Semester III, Semester IV and Semester V in full.

## **Discipline & Code of Conduct**

**Student/s violating these rules will be subject to the Disciplinary action by College.**

- 1) Students must behave properly both inside the class room and in the college premises and he/she must not do anything that will cause disturbance to any class or their fellow students.
- 2) Students must maintain strict silence in the class room, library, reading room and corridors of College
- 3) Loitering in the corridors or sitting on steps or corners is strictly prohibited.
- 4) Smoking and spitting is strictly prohibited.
- 5) No society or association should be formed, no meeting be held, and no person invited to address the students in the college without the prior written permission of the Principal.
- 6) The students are refrained from using the Mobile Phones in the college premises vide circular issued by University of Mumbai No. UG/552 of 2004 dated 31st December, 2004. If any Student found using mobile phone within college premises, same will be confiscated and released on payment of penalty of Rs.100/- as fine.
- 7) Girls should come decently and properly dressed.

## **Attendance and Grant of Terms**

- 1) Attendance of students is regulated by 0.119. The explanation issued by the University vide No.UG/235/98 dated 03/07/98 relating to 0.119 says that  
“For granting of terms, attendance of 75% is mandatory.
- 2) All applications for leave of absence along with medical certificate, if any, should be submitted to the college office.

## **Library Facilities**

College has an updated library with 2500 books on academic subjects and of general interest. Journals, periodicals on various subjects are subscribed. Students are to observe following regulations while using the library.

- Library facilities are provided free of cost to the bonafide students only.
- Every student entering the library premises should have a valid College Identity Card and should be produced as and when demanded by the Library Staff.
- Identity Card & Reader's Ticket are non-transferable.
- Books are issued for 7 days.
- If student fails to return the book on or before the due date, a fine of Rs. 2/-per day per book shall be charged.
- If student fails to return the book even after the completion of final examination, Marksheet of such student shall not be issued to him/her till he/she return the books along with fine or penalty.

## **Book Bank**

College has run Book Bank Scheme for needy students. Interested students may contact the Librarian for membership of Book Bank Scheme.

The College Library has a collection of more than 1000+ text books in book bank facilities provided to Degree College Students on First-cum-first served-basis. Forms are issued to the students on which they have to write their demand for the books. All Subjects books are issued to needy and deserving students. These books are to be returned to the library immediately after the completion of their theory examinations.

Reading Room: 50 students can be accommodated in large and spacious reading room attached to the Main Library. The facility is provided from 12.00 p.m. to 9.00 p.m. (09 hours). Reference Books, Magazines, Daily Newspapers are provided to the students.

## **Refund of Deposits & Caution Money**

- 1) The amount of Caution Money, Library Deposit, Laboratory Deposits, if any, will be refunded when a student leaves the college or cancels the admission. Deposits not claimed within one year of leaving the college or cancellation of admission will be forfeited.
- 2) The amount of deposits will be refunded to the student after 15 days from the date of receipt of their application duly signed by the student and guardian and NOC from the concerned departments.
- 3) Original Deposits Receipt must be surrendered at the time of refund of deposits otherwise he/she stands to forfeit the deposit.

## **National Service Scheme**

N.S.S. National Service Scheme was established in the year 1969, the birth centenary of the Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi. It is identified as "Youth movement on Social Development". Students can enrol themselves in N.S.S. and develop their personality through social service projects. An N.S.S. Volunteer is required to do 120 hours of Social Work in an academic year and at least one special camp of 7 days duration in two years to be eligible for 10 grace marks in the annual examination. The N.S.S. Programme Officers of the College is Prof. Smita Sandeep Jadhav.

## **Security and Safety**

The College offers a very safe and secured environment with Close Circuit Cameras installed at all places. The College also has fire fighting equipment's in place.

## **Railway Concession**

Bonafide students of the college below 25 years are eligible for railway concession for their season tickets. Applications on the prescribed form will be accepted between 5.00 Pm. to 7.00 Pm. on working days in the office. As a proof of residence, student must show his/her ration card.

## **Computer Lab**

The College has a computer lab with 50 computers including server connected with broad band internet connection. All Computers are linked through LAN connections.
